The Gospels are full of examples of Jesus' courageous leadership. Most clearly of all, he embarks upon the way of the cross, knowing what it would cost him – and those who followed him there. His way of leading was radically different, upending the usual priorities.

He taught that:

“Whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be slave of all.” Mark 10 vs43-45

He also challenged hypocrisy and injustice, without fear – overturning tables in the temple, and describing Pharisees as ‘vipers’.

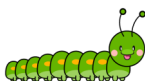
ECO CHURCH
